Michael Polak (TJCC)

During the past year, TJCC Stingray age group swimmers have earned the following individual achievements:

4 SCY LSC records: 11-12 Boys 200/1000/1650 free; 13-14 Boys 1000 free

3 LCM LSC Records: 11-12 Boys 400/800 free; 13-14 Boys 800 free

7 USA Swimming Age Group Top 10 rankings, including a 2nd place

9 USA Swimming Top 100 all-time listings, including two swims in the top 20

As a team, TJCC finished 4^{th} at the 2014 SCY LSC Championships, the highest team finish ever for the Stingrays.
