REMINDER: 2020 RECERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Thank you to those that have recertified!

Be sure your Arizona Officiating certification requirements have been met.

2021 Recertification requirements::: work 4 sessions AND

- 1) Complete the USA Swimming Re certification Test
- 2) Pass a LSC deck check

Or

- 1) Maintain a National Certification at the requested position
- 2) Work an AZ State Championship Meet or OQM (Official Qualifying Meet) eg: Junior Olympics, Age Group or Senior Championships

New training logs and deck check forms have been uploaded to the AZ swimming website. You can locate them by visiting:

- click on **Document Library** drop down tab
- scroll half way down the page and click the officials tab
- viola the new forms are listed under the officials training title

Please use these forms to advance your certification by printing it out and bringing it to your clinic or training meet to accurately guide and document your progress. These forms also double as the deck check forms.

YOU MAKE THE CALL

What is the minimum depth for racing starts from the blocks in practice or competition?

FROM NATIONAL:

As we continue to monitor the changes of this global pandemic, assess the lifting of restrictions across the country and prioritize the health and safety of our members, we are also optimistically planning for our return to competition.

Given the varying timelines expected for a return to training, we have made the decision to modify our upcoming events schedule. National events in July and early August, which include USA Swimming

Sectionals, Futures and the Speedo Summer Championships, will be canceled in order to refocus our efforts on introducing a new series of summer events better tailored to the current environment.

The introduction of 14-16 regional events in mid to late August would allow for a successful return to pools and training and help kickoff the competition season.

These regionally focused events will limit the need for travel and promote a safer competition environment for our athletes, families and everyone involved. The approval of these event sanctions will be subject to local health guidelines and directives. We look forward to providing further details in the coming weeks.

Guidance for Expiring National Certifications Because of Coronavirus

There have been several questions from officials whose National Certifications expire on 6/30/2020, and what they can do regarding them. The good news is that you have three years after the expiration date in order to complete the recertification requirements for that position before you would need to start from the beginning. That means you have until 6/30/2023 to complete any necessary



recertification requirements. However, please note that officials whose certifications expire 6/30/2020 cannot serve as evaluators at an OQM until their certifications have been brought current.

Also, N3 final evaluations need to be completed within 3 years of the N3 initial evaluation. Due to the current shutdown of meets, we are extending the expiration window for officials that received N3-initial evaluations between 3/12/2017-5/31/2017 to 9/1/2020. Depending on when meets can begin again, these dates may be re-evaluated for further extension. We will keep everyone posted as the situation dictates.

New Apparel Vendor

USA Swimming has partnered with a new apparel vendor for meet officials. The new online store has white polo shirts with a new "USA Swimming Meet Official" logo on them. This is where you can order shirts for national meets as well as shirts for LSC meets if your LSC allows them. Note that white polos with the old "meet official" logo are still fine to be used for national meets.

HOW TO HOST A VIRITUAL MEET:

In response to the <u>COVID-19</u> pandemic and its impact on the aquatic community, <u>USA</u>

<u>Swimming</u> is <u>pushing a different model of competition</u> for events sanctioned by the governing body for swimming in the United States – <u>USA Swimming</u> Virtual Meets.

The idea is not new, and was used for years under the guise of "postal meets," but with the need to socially distance and limit the size of crowds, these meets are coming back into focus. Postal meets are still held in some places, including for some US Masters Swimming National Championship events, but are not as common as they once were.

Virtual meets allow club teams to swim locally, but to compete against other teams within their own Local Swimming Committee (<u>LSC</u>).

The guidelines also include instructions for how to set up virtual meets in the Meet Manager software that is used to run most swim meets in the United States.

Although these meets will be held "virtually," they must meet some requirements.



While these meets can extend through various sessions, they must all be held as a single event.

Remember we would need 4 officials to run these meets at the swimming site. A meet Referee, Starter, a S&T, and an AO. It may be possible to share an AO between sites.

Different swim teams can partake in the meet while essentially swimming as intra-squad meets with results being combined to score meets, similar to the old postal meet system (though, more commonly now this won't be done through the actual postal service).

<u>USA Swimming</u> has suggested that a host team be determined, with responsibilities extending from developing meet announcements, establishing an order of events, or merging the results from different intra-squad or smaller site meets for scoring purposes.

The new project would also allow for different LSCs to virtually swim against each other. A team would still host the event and be responsible for duties such as results management

You Make the Call (Answer)

In accordance with rule 103.2; Minimum water depth for racing starts during practice and competition shall be measured for a distance 3 feet 3-1/2 inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from the end wall. Starting requirements and height of starting block shall be in pools with water depth 4 feet (1.22 meters) or more at the starting end, starting platforms shall meet the height requirements of 103.14.1
